Old Business

Repeater

Annual Festive Dinner

It was agreed that the annual festive dinner was a tremendous success, with 16 attendees, a much-improved venue and first-class food. Ian, VE3IJS was heartily congratulated on having organized the event.

Ian reported, however, that we had gone 41% over budget. We had charged \$40 per person, but the main course had cost \$46.48 per person and door prizes an additional \$2.21 per person. More distressingly, on top of this, because many of us were asleep at the switch, enjoying the pre-seasonal ambiance and conversation while the dessert cart rolled in, we all indulged in an extra that was originally intended to have been optional, at each individual’s expense. This added another \$146.20 to the bill, equivalent to \$9.14 per person. The net result was a whopping deficit of \$265.24, or \$16.58 per person..

Although no one specifically expressed the thought, there was perhaps some mild regret at the understandable distress that anyone who did not attend must now be feeling about this redistribution of Club assets. It was agreed, however, that even though the food, and especially the desserts, were excellent, we should not allow this to happen again.

Club P.A. System for Sale

John, VA3AAD reported that Vipi, VE3PID had picked up the Club’s P.A. system and that he had passed on Vipi’s \$50 payment to Bert, VE3ENA, the Club Treasurer.

John reported that Vipi had later stated that the amplifier was inoperable, but that since Vipi had been the last to use it, he should attempt to check it out and repair it.

Sunday Morning Net

John, VA3AAD confirmed that the frequency is 28.550 MHz.

New Business

Club Finances

John, VA3AAD presented the attached PowerPoint summary of Club income and expenses for the 2011-2012 club fiscal year.

The column on the right shows a projection for the entire 2011-2012 fiscal year. The column immediately to the left of it shows what we have actually received and spent to the end of 2011. The third line on page 3 shows that we will probably run a deficit of \$333 for the year. Major reasons for this are:

- The \$265 festive dinner deficit.
- The projected \$150 repeater rent increase.
- A decline in sales of equipment donated to the Club.
- Purchase, for \$79, of 50 blank checks (payable instead of a monthly bank account fee).

After some discussion, it was agreed that:

- We will try to break even on next year's festive dinner.
- We will consider extracting a \$20 fee from Field Day participants.

Financial

The coffee collection yielded \$10.05 and the raffle \$8.00.

Presentation

Tom, VE3BKA gave an outstanding PowerPoint presentation on baluns and ununs (a PDF file is attached) that will serve as a valuable reference on this subject. He also brought in many examples of units that he had constructed.

Next Meeting

Our next meeting will be held on Friday, January 20^h. Elliot, VA3EJF is no doubt working furiously to prepare his presentation, the subject of which has yet to be announced. Let's hope that it includes a progress report on our Linux IRLP software problem. If so we may all no doubt wish to nominate him for an Albert Yates award.
